Wellsville-Middletown R-I senior Tyler Bunch qualified for the Missouri Class 1 State Track in the discus. Tyler qualified for the state meet by placing in the top four in the event at the Class 1 Section 1 track meet held at Oakville High School in south St. Louis County on Saturday, May 12th. Tyler's throw of 131' 7" was a career-best mark and placed him third in the sectional meet. Tyler reset his own school record and his throws in the last four meets all surpassed the previous WM R-I discus record. Tyler will compete in Jefferson City at the state meet on Saturday, May 19th, at 1:30 PM.

Tyler also competed in the shot put event in which he threw a season-best mark of 43' 7". This placed him sixth in that event. Tyler was joined at the sectional meet by the WM R-I boys' 4x200m relay team who qualified for the sectional meet with a third place finish at districts. Senior Jacob Huff, junior Adam Shaw, and freshmen Jordan Harvey and Jacob Hollensteiner ran for a final time this season placing seventh in the event at the sectional meet.
